The City of Phoenix has several areas within the wastewater collection system that have been identified to contain high hydrogen sulfide levels. The high sulfide environment has caused corrosion to occur in several sewer structures within the system. A specific area of concern was an 18" sewer line along the Arizona Canal west of 35th Avenue. Twelve structures were identified for rehabilitation and were coated by Environmental Coatings on May 7th of 2003. The structures have been inspected and no failures have been noted. The City of Phoenix Water Services Department has been very satisfied with the performance of the product and the professionalism of the company.
